COST Workplan - July08-June09

 - Define a set of standardized **DICOM** file headings for pathology microscopic images.

 - Increase the **European scientific leadership** in the **HL7 Pathology SIG** : planning a meeting of the WG2 in conjunction with the HL7 working group meeting

WG2-WG1 relationships (Dr T.Schrader- Dr C.Daniel)

COST IC 604 WG1 (Business modelling in Pathology, Dr T.Schrader) provides a global vision of the business processes in anatomic pathology.

COST IC 604 WG2 (Informatics Standards in Pathology) identifies the most suitable healthcare standards available to implement these business processes. COST IC 604 WG2 members participate to the IHE Planning committee in order to define "Business-driven" IHE integration profiles and white papers. If errors in or the need for extensions to existing standards are identified, IHE's policy is to report them to the appropriate standards bodies (HL7 or DICOM) for resolution and to check that these changes are planned within their road maps.

Brief proposals for IHE 2009-10 cycle

- First year
 - Integrating whole slides images to PACS (in conjunction with DICOM WG26 & jpeg2000 - Complete imaging workflow with PPSM (RAD))
 - Using standard terminologies to code reports and image contents in anatomic pathology (ITI) (in conjunction with IHE ITI : Use case for the Integration Profile "Sharing Value Sets")

- Defining HL7 templates for structured reports in anatomic pathology
- Second year
 - Automations (LAB)
 - Inter-department workflow (LAB)
 - Relationships between Pathology depts, between path dept & endoscopy
 - Relationships between pathology/radiology (in conjunction with IHE PCC, IHE RAD)
- Third year
 - Cross enterprise documents/images sharing (XDS, XDS-I)(ITI)
 - Telepathology (2 Business Processes)
